The Nike Women's Triathlon, a new sprint-distance (.75K swim-20K bike-5K run) event, is coming to town on Sunday, Aug. 5. The 8 a.m. race in Manteno will have a cap of 1,000 participants, will feature warm water and have a flat racing course.

The swim venue and transition area will be at Lake Manteno, southwest of the city.

# FAST-N-FIT FOODS BY JANET SHELLY

### CHEESY HAM & ASPARAGUS BAKE

### INGREDIENTS:

1 1/2 CUPS CHOPPED COOKED HAM

1/2 CUP CHOPPED ONION

1/4 CUP CHOPPED RED BELL PEPPERS

1(10 OZ.) PACKAGE OF FROZEN CUT ASPARAGUS, THAWED

(OR 1 LB. FRESH-CUT UP, STEAMED)

8 EGGS

2 CUPS MILK

1 CUP ALL-PURPOSE FLOUR

1/4 CUP GRATED PARMESAN CHEESE

3/4 TSP. SALT

3/4 TSP. DRIED TARRAGON

1/2 TSP. BLACK PEPPER

1 CUP SHREDDED CHEDDAR CHEESE

### DIRECTIONS:

- 1) PREHEAT OVEN TO 425 DEGREES
- 2) LIGHTLY GREASE A 9x13 IN. BAKING PAN. SPRINKLE HAM, ONION, BELL PEPPER AND ASPARAGUS IN DISH.
- 3) IN A LARGE BOWL, BEAT TOGETHER EGGS, MILK, FLOUR, PARMESAN, SALT, TARRAGON AND PEPPER. BEAT UNTIL SMOOTH AND POUR OVER HAM MIXTURE.
- 4) BAKE UNCOVERED FOR 20 MINS. OR UNTIL KNIFE IN CENTER COMES OUT CLEAN. SPRINKLE WITH CHEDDAR CHEESE. BAKE ANOTHER 3-5 MINS. TIL CHEESE IS MELTED. LET STAND A FEW MINS. BEFORE SERVING.
