I am writing in response to your piece in one of last week's editions. You were challenging the readers of The Journal to improve the quality of the newspaper. After reading your appeal, I decided to write to you with some suggestions I've been hanging on to for a while.

I am a member of the Kankakee Running Club along with my family. We attend many of the area's local races. My husband is an avid runner as are my two children who live to run in any children's event they can find. I am the photographer, cheerleader, water station worker and overall spectator at all of these events. While on the sidelines, I hear all of the stories from participants and their families. I think these would be great things to include in our local newspaper. Runners are a lot like farmers....they love to talk to just about anyone. If your reporters would spend a little time talking to the participants, event coordinators & by-standers, they too could tap into this interesting background knowledge. I must say, I am a little tired of seeing only the MENS winner's photo in the newspaper. What about the LADIES winner, or the KIDS/TEENS winner, or the SENIOR winner? How about the 11 year old at the Bourbonnais Friendship Run that won her age group, was 5th overall for women and it was her FIRST 5K race?! Taylor Bennett is an up and coming star, but no one noticed her achievement. What about the event coordinator for this same race who began running at the same race several years ago and has made great accomplishments since then? Deb Renville is someone your readers should know about. What about John & Marge Flynn who have organized this race for several years and have a star running son? I think these people deserve some recognition in the paper for their accomplishments too. There's more to a race than the fastest male, who sometimes isn't even from our area.

One more topic I would like to see more coverage in is the growing number of runners from our area that are training for the Chicago Marathon. FAST-N-FIT FOODS

Low-Fat Zucchini Bread

3 eggs

1 1/2 c sugar

2 tsp. vanilla

1 c applesauce or Smuckers "Baking Healthy"

2 c shredded zucchini

3 c flour

1 tsp. baking powder

1 tsp. baking soda

1 tsp. salt (optional)

1 c crushed pineapple, well drained

1 c chopped nuts

1/2 c raisins

Beat eggs, vanilla, sugar and applesauce until fluffy. Add zucchini and dry ingredients. Stir in pineapple, raisins and nuts. Bake in 3 well greased and floured 8x4" loaf pans. Bake at 325 degrees for 1 hour. Let set in pans for 10 minutes before turning out onto a rack to cool.
